

BSDS Mohs Logbook FAQ

Q: How do I work out what I can and cannot enter in the different fields concerning Margins?

A: Please read the 'guide' tab (highlighted yellow) on the Excel sheet
There are certain fields that must be completed, macros must be accepted, and results refreshed etc.

Q: How do I sign up and access the BSDS Mohs logbook?

Q: With private cases. Do I need another logbook to record them?

A: practically speaking you can just include private cases - just select private on the NHS/private button (bottom left corner) IG wise you would need to inform your patients i.e. through your privacy policy for your business/private hospital - whoever manages your records. You may already have a suitable clause in your own privacy policy or can add something about quality outcomes and sharing with 3rd party data processors BSDS Privacy Policy can be found here for reference:



Q I have moved to a different location, what do I do?

A: Let us know where you are relocating to. You will continue to have access to your old cases in the previous location. Your old cases will remain visible to others in that location but won't show in the new one. When logging in, it should show your new department as 'default department' Once switched and needing to action the reports' function, you will see an option to select which dept to show personal stats from - so you can download 2 separate graphic reports, or 2 sets of raw excel data and amalgamate yourself if required.

Q I have IT issues, HSCN and IP blocking issues

A: Yes, this is a problem that likely arises from the routing being directed outside the HSCN, and on to the world wide web. The IT department needs to set up a rule that traffic this site should be directed via the HSCN.

You may get a message about incorrect security certificate, but you may be able to click past it. However, if we ever reconfigure our server then you will possibly not be able to connect via this link. Really you need to get the IT department to implement the rule.
